This position carries out responsibilities in all areas of human resources including: employee relations, benefits administration, training, performance management, payroll, policy development and implementation, recruitment/employment and employee orientation.

Essential Duties include:

- Demonstrate, exemplify and support the Capuchin Charism and Provincial Mission, Vision and Values throughout all professional responsibilities and activities
- Develop and administer human resource plan and procedures for employees and ministries.
- Researches, analyzes data and prepares reports on HR trends and new HR project suggestions.
- Recommends and assists in the development, review and implementation human resource policies. Maintain the employee handbook and related policies.
- Participate in developing HR department goals and objectives.
- Provides advice and counsel to employees and managers on employee relations and policy concerns.
- In collaboration, maintain HRIS information and generate reports.
- Maintain compliance with federal, state and local employment and benefits laws and regulations.
- Reviews and recommends annual compensation adjusts based on a Living Wage for the geographic area.
- In collaboration, oversee recruitment, interviews and employment process and procedures.
- Develop and maintain current job descriptions for employees positions.
- Comply with Province and ministry policies, procedures, guidelines and standards.

Qualifications: Bachelor's degree in human resources or human service field or six years experience in similar position. Previous experience working in the non profit environment desirable.
