The Capuchin philosophy is rooted in the Franciscan tradition. With the support of benefactors, volunteers, and other partners, the Capuchin Soup Kitchen serves the Metro Detroit area by providing spiritual encouragement, direction, and material assistance to those in need.

The Capuchin Soup Kitchen serves some 2,000 meals at its two soup kitchens every day of operation.

Every month, the Soup Kitchen services center distributes over 300,000 pounds of food, 30,000 pieces of clothing and more than 500 pieces of furniture.

Every year, the Soup Kitchen serves more than 500,000 meals.

87% of every dollar raised by the Capuchin Soup Kitchen throughout the year goes directly to client services.
